

Life Saver Awards Ceremony Details

At 0113hrs the 911 phone rings

Within 10 seconds, the call taker places the first key stroke into the system, while the same time she is calming and assessing the situation

As emergency assets are notified, Maja Brown is providing the family with basic life support instructions.

Charlie's father is now performing CPR on his 4-week-old daughter

At 0116hrs, 3 minutes after the 911 phone rings, Sheriff's Deputy Randy Paddock arrivals with an AED.

Deputy Paddock takes over patient care from the father, provides CPR, applies the AED, and delivers two shocks to Charlie.

After the second shock with AED, Matt and Curtis from the Woodlawn Volunteer Fire Department arrival and assist in performing CPR, clearly Charlie's airway and continuing patient care until EMS arrives.

Ems arrives on the scene and finds unresponsive, her heart is beating now on its own and she is breathing but less than half to number that is needed.

Baby Charlie is transported and stabilized by the Paramedic and delivered to the hospital.

Charlie spends the next 28 days at Vanderbilt Children's Hospital

Many events transpired after this night that have led to Charlie current Health Status but she her and mom and Dad, Allison and Jason Fenske are all with us to night because of everyone working together to help Baby Charlie.
