Storm Water Contact Policy

All construction projects that require a Grading Permit are required to designate a Storm Water Contact. The Storm Water Contact must hold a current Tennessee EPSC Level I or Level II Certification. <u>The designated</u> <u>Storm Water Contact will be the point of contact for all storm water issues until TDEC has issued a Notice of Termination for that project.</u>

The Storm Water Contact information must be submitted during or before the pre-construction meeting. If an acceptable EPSC level I or EPSC Level II certified person is not designated during the pre-construction meeting, a Grading Permit will not be issued.

The Storm Water Contact information must remain valid until TDEC has issued a Notice of Termination for that project. If the Storm Water Contact changes, the property owner or developer must submit the name and contact information of a new Storm Water Contact Person within five (5) business days. The person named must be EPSC level I or EPSC Level II certified. Failure to comply may result in the revocation of the Grading Permit or a Stop Work Order being issued.
