Subject: Election Sign Policy

The following are guidelines set to help our community with regards to election signs within the city limits of Clarksville.

If you post an election sign on any commercial properties a permit is required. The permit can be obtained at our office and applicable fees are applied. Permits are not required for placement of election signs on residential properties. All election sign placement require owner consent.

- Election signs are prohibited within the right of way or on utility/street sign poles. (The right of way, by general rule, is from utility poles to the curb or edge of pavement). sign found within the right of way will be removed and discarded by the Building and Codes Department.
- Election signs are prohibited on all city owned properties including parks.
- Election signs on commercial properties shall not exceed 32 square feet.
- Election signs on residential properties shall not exceed 6 square feet.
- Election signs shall be removed within 5 days of the completed election.

In accordance with City Ordinance 33-2005-06 permits are required for all signs placed on commercial property regardless of size. Sign permits are issued at a cost of \$25.00 per sign.
