Permanently Registered Voters:

In order to obtain an absentee ballot by mail, you must meet one of the following criteria: over 60 years of age, outside the county during early voting and on election day, student outside the county, disabled, caretaker, commercial driver or spouse of a commercial driver and will be outside the county during early voting and on election day (copy of Commercial Drivers License must be attached), a riverboat worker and will be outside the county during early voting and on election day (copy of Transportation Worker Identification Credentials must be attached)

Submit your request in writing to the Election Commission office. The request can be submitted in person, by mail, by fax, or as a scanned document attached to an email.

Include the following information in your request:

- Name (as registered)
- Residence Address in Montgomery County
- Mailing Address
- Date of Birth
- Social Security Number
- Election and Election Date
- Reason for Voting Absentee
- If primary election include party preference
- Voter Signature

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO VOTER:

Your absentee ballot request is the first step in a process. To have your vote count, you must submit your request, receive your absentee ballot by mail, mark it, and return the ballot by mail to our office. ***Once a ballot has been issued by mail, you can ONLY vote by mail.***

Military and Overseas Civilians:

In order to obtain an absentee ballot by mail, you should submit a **FORM 76** (Federal Post Card Application—FPCA) to the Election Commission in your state and county of residence. The Form 76 is available through your Military Voting Office or online at www.fvap.gov
