

MINUTES  
MONTGOMERY COUNTY REDISTRICTING COMMITTEE  
JULY 20, 2011

A meeting of the Montgomery County Redistricting Committee was held on Wednesday, July 20, 2011 at 1:00 p.m. at the Election Commission Office, 350 Pageant Lane, Suite 404. The meeting was called to order by Committee Chair County Commissioner Ed Baggett. Those present were committee members Commissioner John Gannon, Commissioner Tommy Vallejos, Assessor of Property Betty Burchett, Director of Administration Phil Harpel, Planning Commission Director David Riggins and Administrator of Elections Vickie Koelman. Jimmy Settle also attended the meeting. Mayor Carolyn Bowers, Commissioner Dalton Harrison and Commissioner Lettie Kendall were unable to attend.


Chair Baggett called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone. Vickie Koelman presented the minutes from the July 7, 2011 committee meeting. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Commissioner Vallejos and seconded by Mr. Harpel. The motion carried with a voice vote.

David Riggins reported to the committee that there were no public comments. Several commissioners, school board members and citizens came in during the public comment period to view the plans for information and education.

Vickie Koelman presented and discussed the proposed resolution for the County Commission with the committee. A motion was made by Commissioner Gannon and seconded by Commissioner Vallejos to approve the County Commission Redistricting Plan and the School Board Redistricting Plan as presented and forward both on to the full County Commission at their August meeting. Discussion was held and the motion passed unanimously with a voice vote.
