

ATTENTION DELINQUENT TAXPAYERS

2017 COUNTY AND CITY PROPERTY TAXES

On March 29, 2019 as required by law, suits will be filed in Montgomery County Chancery Court as enforcement of a lien for all unpaid 2017 Delinquent Property Taxes for Montgomery County and the City of Clarksville. Upon filing of the suits, additional penalties and costs will be imposed.

- **2017 Delinquent County Property Taxes may be paid until Thursday, March 28, 2019**, at the Montgomery County Trustee's Office located at the Veterans Plaza, 350 Pageant Ln., Suite 101-B, Phone (931) 648-5717.
- **2017 Delinquent City of Clarksville property taxes may be paid until Thursday, March 28, 2019**, at Finance and Revenue located on the first floor of City Hall, One Public Square, 931-648-7436.
- **After March 28, 2019**, the 2017 and Prior Years Delinquent Property Taxes for the County and City of Clarksville on which suit has been filed must be paid at the Montgomery County Chancery Court/Clerk and Master's Office located at Montgomery County Courts Center, 2 Millennium Plaza, Suite 101, Clarksville, TN, 37040 Phone (931) 648-5703 Office Hours: M-F, 8:00a.m. -4:30 p.m.
