STATE FEE WAIVED ON VEHICLE REGISTRATION RENEWALS

Public Chapter 1143 (2022), effective July 1, 2022, waives the state registration fees for Class A and Class B motor vehicles upon the renewal of the motor vehicle's registration if the renewal occurs after July 1, 2022 and before June 30, 2023. Plates expiring before or after this period will be subject to the ordinary registration fee.

Class A includes motorcycles and autocycles and Class B includes passenger motor vehicles and motor homes. The state portion of the fee that is waived under this law is ordinarily \$16.75 for Class A and \$23.75 for Class B.

What does this mean to me?

- ❖ Renewals Only
 - ❖ Effective **July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023 ONLY**
 - **Class A** plates (motorcycle/autocycle)
 - \$16.75 will be waived
 - **Renewal cost will now be \$79.25***
 - **Class B** plates (passenger/motor homes)
 - \$23.75 will be waived
 - **Renewal cost will now be \$79.25***
- * This amount includes Wheel Tax of \$74.00

Additional Fees that will be owed and ARE NOT waived
