

2022 UPCYCLE Challenge

2022 THEME: Trash to Treasure – Create an entry that showcases how trash can be turned into a decoration that you would find in a home or office.

The item must:

- Be able to be transported to the judging location
- Be something that is recognizable as a decoration you would typically see in a home or office
- Be made from recycled, reused or repurposed items. The only items that may be purchased new are binding materials (i.e. tape, glue, string, etc.). If you are unsure if your item will be allowed contact the Program prior to use.

New for 2022, entries will be divided into two categories.

- Non-profits, government agencies and businesses with 100 or less employees
- Businesses over 101 employees

Please indicate on the entry form which category your entry belongs in.

Entries will be judged based on how closely it matches the theme as well as its durability, creativity and originality. To be considered, the entry must come from a Green Certified organization.

The winning organization will have its name added to the UPCYCLE trophy and that organization will be presented the trophy to display until the 2023 Green Certification Banquet.

An official entry form must be returned at least one week prior to entry judging so we may prepare space and dedicate appropriate time to judge the entries. Judging will take place on the Friday before the 2022 Banquet.

While it is not required, organizations may use the Green Certification logo if they so choose.
