Parking Lot Rules during Early Voting at Veterans Plaza

1. No Loud or Disturbing Noise
2. No Littering or Dumping of Debris
3. No Use of Illegal Drugs or Alcohol
4. No Overnight Parking
5. No Non-Registered Motor Vehicles (e.g. Golf Carts, ATVs, Unattached Trailers, etc.)
6. Tents, tables, signs, and other campaign related materials are only permitted two (2) hours before voting opens and must be removed no later than two (2) hours after voting closes. Such items are not permitted on grass, sidewalks, inside traffic islands, or along the right side of the entrance to the parking lot on Pageant Lane in front of the County Facilities and Maintenance Department.
7. Signs and Banners
 - Signs must be mounted on a vehicle and/or physically held by an individual.
 - Signs on trailers are not permitted.
 - No signs are to be placed on or anchored in the ground.
 - Individuals holding signs are not permitted to stand in the grass areas; stand inside of traffic islands; or block pedestrians, sidewalks, or sight lines for vehicles.
8. Pursuant to T.C.A. § 2-7-111, within 100 feet of the entrance to the election commission, the following activities are prohibited: the display of campaign posters, signs or other campaign materials; distribution of campaign materials; and solicitation of votes for or against any person, political party, or position on a question on a ballot.
