This cause came on for hearing before the Honorable _____, Judge of the Criminal Court of Montgomery County, Tennessee, on the petition of the above defendant for waiver of trial by jury and waiver of the right to have the Jury determine his/her guilt or innocence and request for acceptance of a plea of GUILTY and to submit him/herself to the Trial Judge for decision as to the guilt. And furthermore, upon statements made in open Court by the defendant after having been duly questioned by the court, together with statements made by his/her attorney of record and the District Attorney General, AND

IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that the defendant stated under oath in response to questions by the Court that he/she had been fully advised and understands his/her right to a trial by Jury on the merits of the indictment and of his/her right to have a Jury determine his/her guilt and that the defendant stated that he/she did not elect to have a Jury determine his/her guilt or innocence under a plea of NOT GUILTY, AND

IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that the defendant intelligently and understandingly waives his/her right to a trial by Jury and of his/her own free will and choice and without any threats or pressure of any kind or promises of gain or favor from any source, does now desire to enter a plea of GUILTY and submit him/herself to the Trial Judge to determine his/her guilt and accept the recommendation of the State as to the punishment and waives his/her right for a Motion for a New Trial and/or an Appeal.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the petition filed herein be, and the same is GRANTED.
