**Child Support Court Effective March 15, 2021**

With the recent Supreme Court Order easing the suspension of in-person hearings, the following changes are effective March 15, 2021:

**MONTGOMERY COUNTY:**

- **Contempt** proceedings in Child Support Court will resume in-person.

In light of the recent Supreme Court Order and to prevent a further backlog of contempt matters, reset notices have not been sent by the Montgomery County Child Support Office for March 15, 2021 and beyond.

If both parties and their attorney(s) appear for the original hearing date, we will proceed with the hearing. However, if parties and attorneys fail to appear, the matter will be reset to the date and time assigned in my Memo regarding February and March reset dates and an Order will be placed in your Courthouse Box indicating the reset date.

I will not be issuing attachments or taking any action for failure to appear for a Trial or Review that was to be reset pursuant to my prior memo.

For your convenience those reset dates are as follows:

**March 15, 2021** (Circuit) will be reset to **May 10, 2021**, same time.  
**March 18, 2021** (Juvenile) will be reset to **May 13, 2021**, same time.  
**March 22, 2021** (Chancery) will be reset to **May 3, 2021**, same time.  
**March 25, 2021** (Juvenile) will be reset to **May 20, 2021**, same time.  
**March 29, 2021** (Circuit) will be reset to **May 10, 2021**, same time.

- **Civil Motions** will continue to be heard on the pleadings only.
- **Civil Trials** (Modification / Establish Paternity / Setting Support) will continue to be heard by telephone only unless a special request is made for an in-person hearing.

**ROBERTSON & SUMNER COUNTIES:**

- **Criminal** Arraignments, Reviews and Trials will resume in-person.
- **Civil Trials** (Modification / Establish Paternity / Setting Support) will be heard by Zoom unless a special request is made for an in-person hearing.
