These sites are intended for short periods of stay and shall not allow for extended residential stays and shall not include mobile homes."

- WHEREAS, the City and the County wish to reduce their agreement to a writing in accordance with *Tennessee Code Annotated § 12-9-108*.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants herein contained, the parties hereby mutually agree as follows:

- 1. The City and the County agree that the County will provide for pauper burials.
- 2. The City and the County agree further that the City will pay one-half of the expenses for pauper burials directly to the appropriate funeral home upon receipt of sufficient notice from the County.
