

What you need to get a free library card!

Be a resident of Montgomery County or surrounding areas, and present Photo ID and proof of current address*. Anyone under age 18 needs their parent/legal guardian to obtain a card.

Residents may check out 30 total items, which may include a maximum of 7 DVDS, 7 CDs and 1 Pocket Wi-Fi.

Non-residents pay a \$20.00 per year nonresident fee to be issued a library card. 30 total items, which may include a maximum of 7 DVDS, 7 CDs and 1 Pocket Wi-Fi.

Courtesy and TLC cards can check out 3 items.

*Proof of address includes items such as: Driver's License, Current Utility Bill, Checkbook, Voter's Registration Card, or any postmarked mail with your current name and address.

To visit your library account on the website, you will need: your library card number and your 4digit account PIN.

Looking for items we don't have?

Items that are checked out or are not available can be requested at the Public Service Desks or on our website. If you request an item, it will be held 7 days from the date of the pick-up notice. Please notify us if you no longer need the item, before the 7 days have elapsed.
